| <p>Packet contents</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Ten sheets of green leaf spiders (40) | <p>Other material you will need to complete this build</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - White glue (recommended is a flexible, matt finish glue such as Scenic Textures scenic glue) | <p>Tools you will need to complete this build</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Fine tip felt pen • Smooth sculpting tool • Foam mat (yoga mat or similar) • Tweezers • Scissors |

| <p>Step 1. Carefully remove the ferns from the waste.</p> | <p>Step 2. Using a soft foam mat and a smooth sculpting tool curl the leaves.</p> | <p>Step 3. Turn the spider over and force the centre into the foam</p> |

| <p>Step 4. The leaves bend up as the centre is forced into the foam.</p> | <p>Step 5. Ready for planting.</p> | <p>Step 6. Ferns can be planted using white glue. The spiders can also be stacked to make bushier plants.</p> |
